



Emergency Housing Voucher Program



Who may qualify for the Emergency Housing Voucher Program?

Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) are specifically designed for households who are:

- 1) Homeless, 2) At Risk of Homelessness, 3) Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking, 4) Recently homeless and/or for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness or facing high risk of housing instability.

How do I apply?

Direct referrals for EHV's may only come from the Yuma County CoC's EIS System

Eligibility

Upon referral from CoC's HACP will then determine eligibility to EHV based on HCV eligibility guidelines.

- 1) Intake Appointment, Review & Certify family eligibility
- 2) Voucher Issuance
- 3) Confirm the unit is eligible
- 4) Determine that the rent being charged is reasonable in accordance with the standards established
- 5) Determine the unit meets the Housing Quality Standards (HQS) set by HUD
- 6) Family establishes a new financial interest in the unit.

Eligibility

Upon referral from CoE, HACP will then determine eligibility to EHV based on HHS eligibility guidelines.

- 1) Intake Appointment, Review & Certify Family eligibility, 2) Voucher Issuance, 3) Confirm the unit is eligible, 4) Determine that the rent being charged is reasonable in accordance with the standards established, 5) Determine the unit meets the Housing Quality Standards (HQS) set by HUD, 6) Family establishes a new lease and moves in to unit.
