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### 2020 APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Your application must be postmarked, received by fax, or emailed no later than Friday, July 17, 2020.
- Do not leave any blank spaces on the application. If the question is not applicable to you, enter “NA” in the appropriate space.
- You must be Head of Household to apply. This scholarship will not be awarded to dependents or household members.
- You must be 18 years of age or older to apply.
- This scholarship is only available for Undergraduate Studies. This scholarship is **not** available for General Education Diplomas (GEDs) or Graduate education.
- At the time of the scholarship award, recipient must be enrolled at an accredited community college, vocational school or university for a **minimum** of ½ time or six (6) credit hours.
- **All FSS Participants will receive an automatic 5 points.**
- Scholarship recipients must be in good standing with their housing authority. Housing authorities will be contacted to verify standing.
- Do not add any additional forms, references, resumes, photos, etc. Any additions to the required documentation will mean *automatic denial* of your application.
- Former recipients of this award are not eligible to win.
