WISH PROGRAM **Down Payment Assistance**



The Housing Authority City of Yuma has partnered with the Federal Home Loan Bank of San Francisco and AEA Federal Credit Union to provide homeownership down payment assistance. The WISH Program will quadruple the homebuyers funds and provide a grant of up to \$22,000.

Example:

Homebuyer's Personal Funds = \$1,000 WISH Program X 4 = \$4,000 Grant Total Down Payment Available: \$5,000

Homebuyer's Personal Funds = \$5,500 WISH Program X 4 = \$22,000 Grant Total Down Payment Available: \$27,500
