

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

For all students:

- Present 2 to 3 forms of ID for yourself (<u>one must include your photo</u>, <u>date of birth</u>, and <u>all be unexpired</u>), 1 form of ID per person in household unit, and proof of family household income.
- Fees vary between \$60.00 and \$100.00 per Quarter. Fee is determined on a sliding scale by total household size and family household income in a year. Fee does not apply if on probation or parole; ask for details.
- Make payment by the time of Orientation Appointment OR First Day of Class (unless prior payment arrangements have been made with the Main Office); payable in: cash, check, or money order. *Fee is non-refundable or transferrable between Quarters once paid*.
- Be withdrawn from the public school system.

For students 16 or 17 years:

- Official withdrawal form from last school attended.
- If home-schooled, parents must request a withdrawal form from the County Superintendent's Office indicating the student will no longer be home-schooled. For more information, please contact:

MANDATORY PROGRAM APPOINTMENTS



- Complete Intake to schedule an Enrollment and Assessment Appointment; have ready 2-3 IDs for yourself, 1
 ID per person living in household unit, AND proof of total family household income to determine
 appropriate Tuition Fee for the Quarter.
- Complete Enrollment and Assessment, then schedule your Orientation Appointment.
- Upon completion of Orientation you will obtain your assessment results, individual program of study, and school schedule.
- Make payment by the time of Orientation Appointment OR First Day of Class (unless prior payment arrangements have been made with the Main Office); failure to do so may prompt a delay in the start / continuation of your classes.
