WISH PROGRAM Down Payment Assistance



The Housing Authority City of Yuma has partnered with the Federal Home Loan Bank of San Francisco and AEA Federal Credit Union to provide homeownership down payment assistance. The WISH Program will quadruple the homebuyers funds and provide a grant of up to \$22,000.

Example:

1. Homebuyer's Personal Funds = \$1,000 WISH Program X 4 = \$4,000 Grant Total Down Payment Available: \$5,000

2020 Car Seat Program Qualifications

The class will teach you the proper way to install a child restraint, and how to determine which seat is the safest for your child. It is necessary for you to bring your vehicle so we can make sure the child restraint is installed correctly in your vehicle.

Any individual who is currently enrolled in either the WIC program, has AHCCCS insurance, or receives food stamps is eligible to take this class and receive one child restraint. You must be able to show proof of the program you are enrolled in. (WIC folder, AHCCCS/Food Stamp Card)

Anyone can attend the class for educational purposes, but only those that are enrolled in one of the three programs mentioned above will be eligible for a free seat.
